CALL FOR ENTRIES: The Bellport-Brookhaven Historical Society invites Bellport High School students to submit their original artwork to *AN ARTISTS' PLACE – NOW Juried Art Exhibition* which will be on view at the BBHS's Brown Building Gallery, Pokorny Room, located at 12 Bell Street, Bellport.

CRITERIA: All styles from abstract to realism are welcome. Subject must represent your interpretation of Bellport, Brookhaven and/or East Patchogue now.

MEDIUMS: Including but not limited to acrylic, oil, watercolor, pastel, mixed media, digital art, collage, encaustic, etching/prints. NO COPIES, PHOTOGRAPHY, REPRODUCTIONS OR GICLEES will be accepted.

SIZE: Maximum size 30 x 30 inches including frame.

Entries cannot exceed 30" in any direction.

All artwork must be properly prepared and ready to display, wired and ready to be hung.

All entries must be labeled on the back with the artist's name, grade, title of work and medium.

Completed Submission Form must accompany the entry at time of drop-off.

Entries should be dropped-off at the BBHS Brown Building, located at 12 Bell Street, Bellport on Monday, June 3, between 3:00 – 5:00 p.m.
