**TESTING INFORMATION**

- The **Living Environment and Algebra Common Core Regents Exams** are scheduled for **Wednesday, June 15<sup>th</sup>** and **Thursday, June 16<sup>th</sup>** respectively. Students taking these exams will be excused from their regularly scheduled classes during the administration window.
- **Friday, June 17<sup>th</sup>** is the **last regular school day** (7:55-2:32) for all Middle School students.
- **Final Exam Week begins Monday, June 20<sup>th</sup>**. During this week, students should *report to school only for the final exams scheduled* for their courses (please see Exam Schedule enclosed).
- Buses will run at the times listed on the exam schedule. This schedule has been shared with students and is posted on the BMS website ([http://www.southcountry.org/schools/bellport\\_middle\\_school](http://www.southcountry.org/schools/bellport_middle_school)).
- There will be restricted access into the building through the Main Entrance during the Finals Week to students taking exams only (June 20<sup>th</sup> - June 24<sup>th</sup>, 2016). *Upon arrival, students are to report directly to their examination or review session.*
- Students should come prepared with a pen and #2 pencils to all examinations.
- Please bring calculators to all appropriate examinations.
- Backpacks, large handbags, gym bags, musical instruments and all such items are not permitted in the testing rooms. If a student enters the room with any of these items, the items will be collected and stored at the student's own risk.
- **Students are encouraged to leave all electronic devices, including cell phones, at home.** If a student uses any such device or related communications technology during the administration of any examination (local or Regents), the student risks having their test invalidated with no score calculated.
