**NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY
INDUCTION INFORMATION**

Acceptance into the Bellport Chapter of the National Honor Society is obtainable for students (grades 10-12) who meet the following Eligibility requirements as defined in the NHS Bylaws:

- a. Candidates eligible for selection to this chapter must be members of the sophomore, junior or senior class.
- b. To be eligible for selection to membership in this chapter, the candidate must have been enrolled for a period equivalent to one semester at Bellport High School.
- c. Candidates eligible for selection to the chapter shall have a minimum weighted cumulative grade point average of 90% at the time of application (10th, 11th, and 12th).
- d. Upon meeting the grade level enrollment and GPA standards, candidates shall then be considered based on their service, leadership and character.

In addition, the Bellport Chapter requires students to perform six (6) hours of documented community service between July 1st and February 1st during the school year of application (prior to the student's consideration for selection). Finally, a total of twelve (12) community service hours is required every school year. It is important students who are interested in receiving an invitation to the Bellport Chapter of the National Honor Society begin working on the above-mentioned requirements at the start of their high school career.

Invitations to complete an application will be sent to students meeting the academic component of eligibility approximately one month prior to the National Honor Society Induction Ceremony. This year's induction ceremony is scheduled for Tuesday, April 23, 2019 (attendance at the Induction Ceremony is mandatory). Final determination on acceptance will be made by the NHS Faculty Council.
