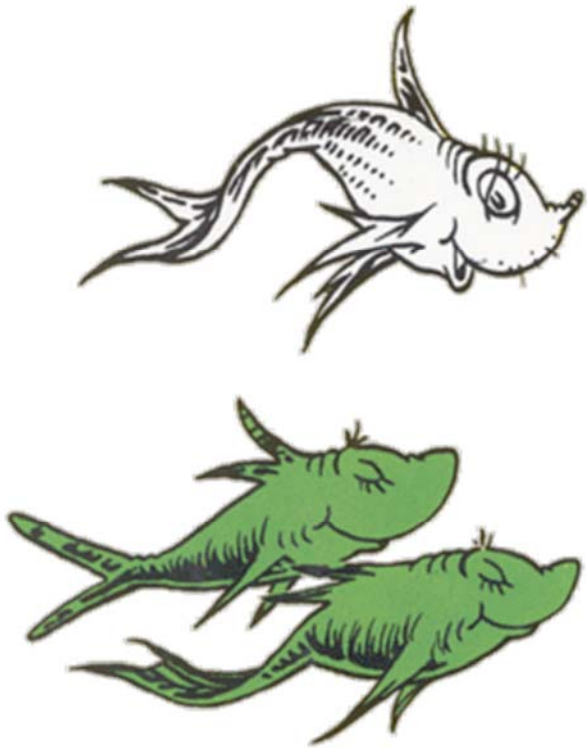


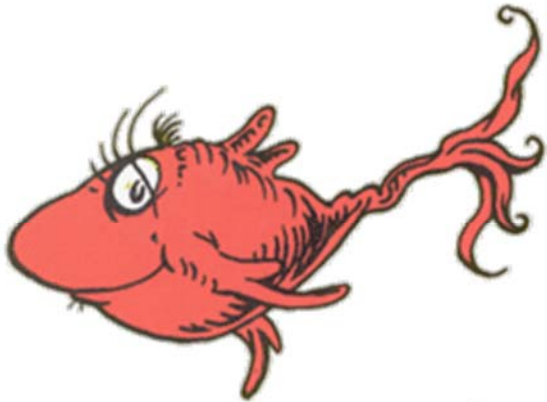

We have some exciting news that this year our school will be participating in a nationwide event called “Read Across America Day.” This special day honoring Dr. Seuss’ birthday will be celebrated with a Dr. Seuss themed week including spirited activities to celebrate some of his favorite book titles and honor his contribution to early literacy. Upon return from our Mid-Winter Recess (February 25<sup>th</sup>- March 1<sup>st</sup>), children have the opportunity to show their Seuss spirit with a different theme each day! Students will be introduced to each Dr. Seuss book which will be followed by various activities to go along with themes of the book. On Friday March 1<sup>st</sup>, this year’s Read Across America Day all students will be participating in a school wide reading event in the afternoon whereby all classes will stop all activities and read for about 15 minutes. Below you will find a quick outline of our week ahead.
