Dear Brookhaven Elementary School Community:

I received notification today that there was one student and two staff members from Brookhaven Elementary School who tested positive for COVID-19. The student tested positive on Sunday, January 24, 2021 and was last in school on Friday, January 22, 2020.

Both staff members tested positive for COVID-19 on Tuesday, January 26. The first staff member was last in school on Friday, January 22 and the second staff member was last in school on Monday, January 25.

In accordance with the District's reopening plan, we have notified the Suffolk County Department of Health, the agency responsible for case investigation and contact tracing in Suffolk County. In review of the schedule of the student, it has been determined that there have been (14) students and (2) staff members in close contact during the infectious period. As a result, these individuals will remain home and receive further guidance from the department of health. Students will shift to remote learning at home.

In review of the schedule of the staff members, it has been determined that there have been (5) staff members in close contact during the infectious period. As a result, these individuals will remain home and receive further guidance from the department of health.

Moving forward, please know that we will continue to be diligent in following our COVID-19 safety practices. We appreciate the cooperation of all building stakeholders (faculty, staff and students) in ensuring our school remains a healthy and safe environment for all.
