PROPOSITION NO. 2

RESOLVED, that the South Country School District be authorized, effective with the 2010-2011 school year, to provide for full (no minimum mileage limitation) transportation (in lieu of the present limits of (1/2) miles for students in grades K-3; (1) mile for students in grades 4-8; and $(1 \frac{1}{2})$ miles for students in grades 9-12) for all district students, grades K-12, at the approximate additional cost of \$263,072 and that the necessary amount therefore be raised by a levy upon the taxable property of the School District at an estimated additional tax increase of \$1.00 per \$100.00 of assessed valuation.

The Proposition was DEFEATED by the voters.
