RESOLUTION DELEGATING TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE SOUTH COUNTRY CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT AT BROOKHAVEN, SUFFOLK COUNTY, NEW YORK, THE POWER TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF AND TO SELL NOT EXCEEDING \$23,000,000 TAX ANTICIPATION NOTES OF SAID SCHOOL DISTRICT IN ANTICIPATION OF THE COLLECTION OF TAXES LEVIED OR TO BE LEVIED FOR THE FISCAL YEAR OF

SAID SCHOOL DISTRICT COMMENCING JULY 1, 2010.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the South Country Central School District at Brookhaven, Suffolk County, New York, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Subject to the provisions of the Local Finance Law, the power to authorize the issuance of and to sell not exceeding \$23,000,000 tax anticipation notes of the South Country Central School District at Brookhaven, Suffolk County, New York, including renewals thereof, in anticipation of the collection of taxes levied or to be levied for the fiscal year of said School District commencing July 1, 2010, is hereby delegated to the President of the Board of Education. Such notes shall be of such terms, form and contents, and shall be sold in such manner, as may be prescribed by said President of the Board of Education, consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
